



COVID-19 RESPONSE UPDATE

Below is an informational update on the status of the County Parks and park operations for campers. - The campgrounds at Pioneer Park, Meinert Park, and Blue Lake Park are **TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED TO OPEN FOR REGULAR CAMPING Saturday, June 13, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. THIS DATE IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE** pending directives from the State of Michigan and Public Health Muskegon County.
- Motor Vehicle Permits will be required starting May 29th. Options for Permits are: \$5.00 for a daily permit, or \$20 for an annual sticker.
- Restrooms will not be open until at least June 13th.
- Campground reservations are available online only at www.muskegoncountyparks.org.
- All campers are asked to be self-contained if possible, as restroom and bathhouse access may be restricted due to potential disinfection and sanitation limitations. If you have a blue buddy tank, please bring it along to extend your black water tank capacity. Parks have dump stations for buddy tank dumping.
- Check in at Pioneer Park will still take place in the main office. We ask that only one person from your party complete the check-in, and for only one person at a time inside of the office during check-in.
- At this time, and until further notice, the playgrounds and playground equipment at all County Parks are closed to the public.
- For the safety of campers and Muskegon County Parks staff and until further notice, we ask that people maintain a 6-foot distance in all personal interaction with Park personnel and other campers.

- We ask that if you or a member of your family or friends are ill, please do not use the Muskegon County Parks until symptoms have subsided.
